Clean, dry and crisp, with a creamy finish. (1) 11.5%vol

Cornwall, UK
Superb golden sparkler with elegant fizz and full, ripe flavour, packed with elderflower and hedgerow notes, yet truly brut. (1) 12.5%vol
- 3. JOSEPH PERRIER CUVÉE ROYALE BRUT NV** Bottle **£36.50**
Champagne, France ½ Bottle **£18.00**
One of the great overachieving, underestimated small Champagne houses. It has a relaxed, easy-drinking style with a warm brioche weight to support its fresh apple fruit. (1) 12%vol
- 4. BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE BRUT NV** Bottle **£49.50**
Champagne, France
Firm, with yeasty, brioche note following through to enrich the fruit flavour. Taut style and solid finish. (1) 12%vol
- 5. BOLLINGER ROSÉ BRUT NV** Bottle **£55.00**
Champagne, France
Created from 62% Pinot Noir, 24% Chardonnay and 14% Pinot Meunier, in the meticulous House style, Bollinger Rosé shows delicate aromas of ripe red fruits, and powerful elegance. Difficult to analyse, it is both bullish and has the finesse of classical ballet. It is immensely complex - tightly wound like a coiled spring - and utterly wonderful. (1) 12%vol

Red wines are designated letters A to E with A being the lightest and softest and E being the deepest and fullest with a concentrated flavour.

Tamar Ridge, Tasmania
This is no shrinking violet Pinot Noir. It is full of cinnamon spice and cherry fruit with attractive burnt-toffee notes. It is silky smooth with elegant fine tannins to bring out the berry fruits. One of the neatest and most elegant Pinots we have found Down Under for years. (B) 13.5%vol
- 31. VALPOLICELLA SUPERIORE, TOMMASI 2009/10** Bottle £21.50
Italy
Dark cherry character and nice meaty flavours. Perfectly full-bodied and balanced wine from this dynamic Veneto producer. (C) 12%vol
- 32. RIOJA RESERVA, MARQUES DE MURRIETA 2005/06** Bottle £31.50
Spain
One of the grandest Riojas - all super-sweet and oaky. The big style emphasizes the intense ripe berry fruit and the busty oak offers overtones of toffee, coffee and coconut. (C) 14%vol
